## 3-Way Diff/Merge tool.

The new 3-way merge tool is a major enhancement to the diff/merge capabilities built into SpectrumSCM. The 3-way tool allows the user to do side-by-side comparison between two different versions of a file and a common ancestor. This is in contrast to most 3-way tools that use the common ancestor information as a foundation for an automated three way merge but still only displays the results of the merge in a 3rd window. SpectrumSCM's 3-way tool allows the user to browse the differences between all three of the files involved in the merge before requiring the user to merge the changes together. SpectrumSCM's 3-way merge tool makes use of the same high performance difference reconciliation facilities that are found in the current SpectrumSCM 2-way merge tool.

## CR filtering mechanism to enhance the management of Change Requests

Users can create SQL like queries for CRs and assign them to filters. This allows users to quickly zero in on just the CRs that they want to see. What's exciting about this feature is that the filters are reusable on several different screens within the tool. This capability is unique in that users can use this feature to control the visual content of the user interface outside of standard report output. This can be very important to program managers and project leads who need to sort through all of the change requests in their system in order to visualize the overall state of their projects.

## Enhancements to preferences

In particular, we have added an entire section on what action to take on an unlock operation. The user now has control over what happens to the unlocked file once the operation has completed, e.g. should the file be left as is, deleted, refreshed from the server, or simply set to read-only status.

#### Eclipse enhancements

Eclipse integration now has added functionality for workspace synchronization, change request creation and progression, default editing and a series of other changes that add more SpectrumSCM functionality to the Eclipse platform.

#### Visual Studio integration enhancements

Major enhancements in overall speed and reliability have been added to the Visual Studio integration. The VS.NET plug-in now supports project mapping, unlock preferences, and the ability to use VS.NET with the new SpectrumSCM Client Proxy. What's exciting about this is that now VS.NET users can use the SpectrumSCM Client Proxy feature to further speed development of globally distributed applications.
